Subject: Park Replanting Project Summary

At the July 13, 2023 Board of Directors meeting the Board approved up to \$50,000 to expend on park improvements and safety improvements. This approval included the approval by the Board to move forward with a replanting project as outlined in that same board meeting.

As we move towards the end of fiscal year 2024, I can report that the specific park replanting project is completed. This involved the construction of a viewing deck, the planting of trees and the staining, repairing of benches in the park along moving some of the benches in better strategic locations. A barrier was also placed at the top of the park in an attempt to stop people from using a walkway that was not designated and was essentially causing erosion. The total cost for this project came to \$31,245.


I would also like to thank the Police Officers Association and Scouts BSA Troop 100 for their donations toward this project. In addition, the following work was done at the park:

- bollards at the parking lot were installed for safety reasons;
- parking spaces and crosswalk were restriped and the fire lanes were repainted;
- railing between the Community Center and amphitheater were replaced, the stairs behind the Community Center were removed and a fence barrier was installed and the electrical cage on the west side of the Community Center was replaced; and
- gutters and down spouts were repaired/replaced on the recreation building.

These costs totaled \$18,830. Over the course of this fiscal year there were other items addressed, either because of damage, wear and tear, or minor improvements. The cost for these items fell under the repair portion of the operating budget.
