A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KENSINGTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT SUPPORTING KPPCSD'S PLAN TO ACQUIRE THREE PATHS FROM CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Kensington Fire Protection District ("KFPD") and Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District ("KPPCSD") have initiated the process to reorganize into one district; and

WHEREAS, both KFPD and KPPCSD understand that decisions related to operations and maintenance of individual districts may impact future expenditures of the combined district; and

WHEREAS, because Contra Costa County ("County") desires to quitclaim three paths (Ardmore, Beloit and Coventry) to KPPCSD pursuant to an agreement which is currently being considered; and

WHEREAS, as part of the agreement, KPPCSD would receive \$35,000 per year for five years from the County for maintenance and KPPCSD would also allocate \$30,000 per year towards a capital reserve fund for future capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, the KFPD Board of Directors has reviewed the information on the planned agreement and recognizes that the transfer of ownership would benefit the community; and

WHEREAS, the KFPD Board of Directors is in support of this plan for transfer of ownership and would like to convey this to the KPPCSD Board of Directors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Kensington Fire Protection District hereby conveys their support for the KPPCSD's plan to acquire three paths from the County with the related five-year maintenance funding and commitment to allocate annual capital reserve funding.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Kensington Fire Protection District on the 16th day of April 2025 by the following vote of the Board.
