On 06-12-19, at approximately 2005 hours, Kensington Police Officers were dispatched to a report of Domestic Violence in the 000 block of Anson Way. The Victim advised the Suspect, Che Hoskins had left the scene and was no longer in the area.

Kensington Police Officers arrived on scene and through the course of the investigation it was learned that the Victim broke off an engagement with her Fiancé Hoskins. The Victim suffered Great Bodily Injury. This all occurred as the Victim's 7 year old child was in the home. Kensington Fire E-65 responded to the scene for medical attention. Kensington Police Officers obtained an Emergency Protective Order (EPO) approved by the on-call Judge.

Officers responded to the place of employment for Hoskins in the City of Berkeley. Hoskins later returned to work to speak with police at which time he was arrested for one (1) felony count PC 273.5(A) and one (1) felony count PC 245(A)(4). Hoskins was then transported and booked in to the Contra Costa County Martinez Detention Facility without incident.

The suspect is identified as Che Hoskins, DOB 06-18-1971, a 48 year old male out of Concord, California. The arrestee was booked for the two above mentioned charges with a total bail amount was set at \$65,000.00.
