On 05-09-19, at approximately 2120 hours, the Kensington Police Department (KPD) was dispatched to a police assistance call made by an anonymous caller. KPD located a black male adult, approximately 40 years old, wearing a jacket with a hood on, sitting on a bench near the store group on Arlington Avenue.

The BMA matched the description provided was sitting on a bench, under cover of a blanket near 291 Arlington Avenue. KPD spoke with the individual to identify him. KPD requested the assistance of Albany Police Department who arrived on scene to assist. Through information provided by the BMA and the use of Albany Police Department Cal Photo system the suspect was positively identified.

A records check of the suspect's information yielded several warrants. Warrant number one was out of the City of Berkeley which was eligible for cite release, warrant number two out of the City of Oakland which was eligible for cite release and warrant number three which had no extradition was out of the State of Louisiana. All warrants were confirmed and the suspect was arrested and later released on citations.

The suspect is identified as Randy Jones Sr., DOB 05-16-1962, a 56 year old male out of Berkeley, California. The arrestee was cite released on the two warrants from the City of Berkeley and the City of Oakland that had a total bail amount set at \$1,359.00.
