Two suspects have been charged by the Contra Costa District Attorney for the residential burglaries of homes that were staged pending sale.

Both suspects, residents of Richmond California, have been charged with residential burglaries that occurred on or about September 21, 2017, at 255 Columbia Ave. and a second that occurred on or about August 21-24, 2017, at 567 Marine Ave. Richmond.

Suspect #1 Daniel McGill, is a white male adult 5'10" tall weighing approximately 200 pounds with long brown hair, green eyes born on 1/10/1969.

Suspect #2 Martha Brooks, is a Hispanic female 5'5" weighing approximately 130 pounds with brown hair, brown eyes, born on 10/13/1970.

The District Attorney's office has charged 2 counts Second Degree Burglary (PC459) and 1 count Receiving Stolen Property (PC496(b)).

Suspects were previously arrested by El Cerrito PD for the burglaries committed in Kensington, El Cerrito, and Richmond but have since been released pending a plea agreement.
