Summary of Incident:

On Saturday, August 20, 2016, at approximately 1618 hours, the Kensington Police Department responded to a call of domestic violence in the 200 block of Yale Avenue in Kensington.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the incident started within the house before escalating to outside in front of the residence where the victim was struck by a Chrysler PT Cruiser driven by the suspect who has been identified as (Renee Gullixon, age 51) of Kensington.

The force of the impact caused the victim to land on the hood, smashing the windshield and ultimately being thrown to the street. The victim was hospitalized as a result of his injuries. A search warrant was served on the residence to gather evidence resulting in officers locating narcotics, drug paraphernalia and a gun which were removed from the home.

As this incident was taking place the suspect's thirteen year old child was home in his room and not injured. The child has since been removed from the house and placed with other family in the area.

Gullixon was arrested on charges of PC 245 (a)(1) (Assault with a deadly weapon, HS 11378 (Possession of Methamphetamine for Sale), HS 11350 (Possession of Controlled Substance), PC 273a(a) (Felony Child Abuse), PC 25100(c) (Criminal Storage of a Firearm in the First Degree), PC 273.5(a) (Domestic Violence).
