On December 4th 2018, at approximately 2012 hours, Officer Ramos received a call about a possible wanted person in Kensington located in the area of Trinity Avenue and Kenyon Avenue. The possible location was identified through an IPAD ping. Officers Ramos and Foley were able to further narrow the location to one of three residences on the 200 block of Trinity Avenue.

Officers Ramos and Foley confirmed the subject had active felony warrants totaling \$230,000.00 dollars and made contact with a resident in the 200 block of Trinity Avenue. The resident confirmed that the subject was a friend and was located in the residence. The resident gave consent to enter the residence and the subject was taken into custody without incident

The subject was taken to the Kensington Police Department for processing. The subject was identified as Michael Jason Adams, DOB 12/01/1976 out of Santa Rosa, California. The subject had multiple warrants out for PC 245 assault with a deadly weapon charges. The subject also had a PC 3455 violation of parole warrant. After being processed the subject was transported to the Contra Costa County Main Detention Facility.
