Subject: Review Draft Resolution of Name Change from Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District to Kensington Community Services District

Recommendation

This is for discussion and to answer questions residents may have regarding this name change. The plan would be for the board to consider it for approval at the March 13, 2025, the board of directors meeting for KPPCSD.

Background

THIS IS A DISCUSSION ITEM ONLY. NO ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AT THIS MEETING.

The name change is reflective of the movement of the fire district dissolving and becoming part of the community services district. According to Community Services District law, there are many powers allowable which include police powers and fire services. The name change will better reflect all the services the district provides.

In a Zoom meeting with California Special District Association staff which included their CEO, Head of Advocacy and Legal Services, they all agreed that they did not see any issues with the name change having a detrimental effect on the ability of either fire or police to obtain grants that may be available in the years to come.

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
KENSINGTON POLICE PROTECTION AND COMMUNITY
SERVICES DISTRICT CHANGING THE DISTRICT'S NAME
TO "KENSINGTON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT"**

WHEREAS, the Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District ("KPPCSD") was formed pursuant to the Community Services District Act, commencing with Section 61000 of the California Government Code; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 61061(b) authorizes a community services district to change the name of the district, by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of KPPCSD desires to change the name of the district to "Kensington Community Services District" to better reflect the broader array of services it shall provide following its reorganization with the Kensington Fire Protection District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District resolves, as follows:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. Name Change. The Board of Directors of KPPCSD hereby changes the name of Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District to "Kensington Community Services District," ("KCSD") and directs staff to file a copy of this resolution with the Secretary of State, the State Board of Equalization, the county clerk, the county auditor, the board of supervisors, and LAFCO for Contra Costa County.
